



Ordinance Number 28

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES, CHARGES, AND RULES FOR THE SERVICE OF THE VILLAGE OF FREEPORT, MICHIGAN WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTER RELATIVE TO SAID SYSTEM.

THE VILLAGE OF FREEPORT, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The rates and charges for the use of and for the service supplied by the Village of Freeport Water Supply System be and same are hereby as follows:

- (a) For all users at a rate of Four Dollars and SO/100 (\$4.SO) per quarter plus Sixty Cents (\$.60) per thousand gallons.
- (b) For all hydrants a rental of One Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$125.(0) per annum.
- (e) For miscellaneous services for which the judgment of the Village Council, a special rate should be established. Such rates shall be fixed and established by the Village.

SECTION 2. Bills for rates and charges as herein established shall be sent quarterly. All bills shall be payable on or before the 10th day of the month following the receipt of the bill and be paid at the office of the Treasurer of the Village. If any charge for the services of the system shall not be paid by the 10th day of the month in which it shall become due and payable, a delayed payment charge of Ten per cent (10%) of the amount of the bill shall be added thereto and collected therewith. If any bills for the service of the water system shall remain unpaid after thirty (30) days following the rendition of the bill therefore, the water supply for the lot, parcel of land, or premise affected shall be cut off and not be turned on except on payment in full of the delinquent therefore, in addition to the payment of a charge of Five Dollars (\$5.00).

SECTION 3. Applications for water service shall be filed with the Village Clerk upon a form to be supplied by the Village. The application shall state the name of the applicant and the premises to be served. All applications shall be accompanied by a fee of (\$15.00), payable to the Village Treasurer for connection charge.

SECTION 4. It is hereby the duty of the Village Treasurer to render bills for water service and all other charges in connection therewith and to collect all monies due.

SECTION 6. All revenues and monies derived from the operation of the water system shall be paid to and held by the Treasurer separate and apart from all other funds of the Village and an of said sums and all other funds and monies incident to the operation of said system as may be delivered to the Treasurer shall be deposited in a fund designated as the "Water System Fund." and said treasurer shall administer said fund in every respect m a manner provided by the laws of Michigan and another laws thereto.

SECTION 6. The Village Clerk be and is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance once in The Freeport News, a newspaper of general circulation in the Village of Freeport Michigan promptly after adoption.

SECTION 7. All ordinance and parts of ordinance insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby rescinded.

SECTION 8. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
