

## Water Committee Meeting

April 07, 2016

### **Members present:**

Meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM

Our first topic discussed was regarding replacement of a mud valve and the cleaning of our water tower. Dixon is the company that will be performing the work, and not Global as presented at the last council meeting. Error is to be corrected at the next council meeting on April 11, 2016.

Dates need to be set for a state required Reliability Study that is currently 4 years overdue.

There are 16 water services that are currently in need of repair which our DPW is in the process of completing prior to an April 15 deadline which was set by Al Scholma at last month's water committee meeting.

Attendees were able to view the most recent water test results, and committee members reviewed the Past-Due Water Bill packets for the current month. Also, the numbers of gallons pumped to actual usage were reviewed and found to be within range of the  $\pm 10\%$ . The numbers are as follows:

Total Usage: 1,376,300 gallons

Total Pumped: 1,411,000 gallons

Difference: 35,000 gallons

The question of water shut-off for non-payment in terms of days was voiced by Tim McKay. The answer seems to be after 60 days, delinquency could result in the shut-off of services.

April 11, 2016 water hydrants are to be flushed.

John Raymond has requested the history of repairs that have been completed, and materials that were used in those repairs, & a map of the village to find potential lead "goosenecks" that connect some service lines to the stop boxes. There is only a very small number of these connections, but this is a proactive approach to prevent any potential contamination sources and to verify which water service points have been updated to newer standards of copper piping and plastic supply feeds. Bill Andrews has agreed to provide copies of service logs and a map.
