

Water Committee Meeting

October 10, 2016

Meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM

Topics Discussed:

Water samples have been received for annual copper and lead reporting. All samples were below the **Maximum Contaminant Level** that is regulated by the DEQ.

Sample LG78658 **Not Detected** for Copper or Lead

Sample LG78659 **.07mg/L Copper, Not Detected** for Lead

Sample LG78660 **.27 mg/L Copper, Not Detected** for Lead

Sample LG78661 **Not Detected** for Copper or Lead

Sample LG78662 **Not Detected** for Copper or Lead

Copper has a MCL of 1.3 mg/L

Lead has a MCL of .015 mg/L

Water samples for radium, and gross alpha are out for testing and should be back this month sometime. The DEQ has forwarded these samples to Fort Collins, Co for completion.

We discussed water samples that can be tested for several different chemicals in addition to standard coliform organism testing. This sample process is currently completed annually for state compliance. We will begin sampling in this format quarterly, and then trending the data to watch for any abnormalities that may occur.

5 water meters are in need of repair, and Chris Shepard will work on the completion of the repairs.

Fire hydrants are scheduled to be flushed on October 10th, and the work will begin at 10 PM.

Flow testing for the fire hydrants will need to be completed on or before October 20th.
