Water Main System Flushing

August 6th & 7th, 2014
9:00am to 4:00pm

This procedure of flushing the village water supply distribution system is necessary to remove the sedimentation that accumulates in water mains throughout the system. On the days posted above, hydrants across town will systematically be opened to scour the main lines and remove buildup and sedimentation.

During this time, you may experience rusty or colored water. Every effort will be made to prevent this and though it may appear unpleasant it is not a health hazard.

Helpful Hints: If you experience rusty or colored water.

- 1- Run water through an out door spigot tap.
(Into a pail or glass jar until it clears.)
- 2 - Run water through an indoor faucet tap.
(Remove screen for best flow and/or cleaning.)
- 3 - Avoid doing laundry, especially whites. (Until you are sure the house plumbing is clear of stray sediment, see 1& 2 above.)
- 4 - It is a good idea: To flush you Hot Water Heater Tank and clear any sediment.
Be cautious, the water is **hot**.
