Received water sample LH91563 with a "positive" result for coliform organisms. 5 additional samples were taken LH92822-LH92826 to verify a "not detected" result in place of the positive result.

Discussed the addition of a back-up water operator.

No water meter repairs were completed this month by the DPW. A new count of needed repairs will be made prior to next month's meetings.

A water main repair on Warren Street has been identified to have a lead gooseneck. Removal of the lead will happen as the repair work is completed.

Water bill cards are being damaged at the post office. Any preferences or ideas to fix the issue would be appreciated and will be discussed at the next round of meetings in September.

A replacement marker light for the water tower will be purchased this month.
