

## Water Committee Minutes

January 2, 2019

Present: Lani Forbes, John Raymond, Russ Yarger

Meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM

Discussed need for Village owned credit card because more vendors are requiring purchases be made using a card. A purchasing policy will be drafted and established soon.

Discussed the possibility of contracting labor for identifying and replace lead plumbing that could be in our water system. This is a required DEQ 5-year project.

Discussed the separation of water services for the church and former parsonage house.

Raymer was in to evaluate our well pumps because they pump different amounts while being identical in size and component. They determined there were no issues and have been pumping at different levels since their installation.

During a monthly check of the back-up generator for the pump house, it was discovered while it did start up just fine, it also failed under a full-load condition. A repair request will be made by the DPW.

Chlorine levels have been recently adjusted with some assistance from MRWA. Hydrants were flushed, and chlorine levels were checked at key locations in the water system, and a revised flushing procedure will be soon to follow, as a result.

We are looking into the feasibility of installing a solar array to produce our energy needs for our well pumps, water tower marker, and pump house lighting.
