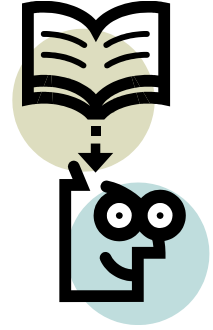

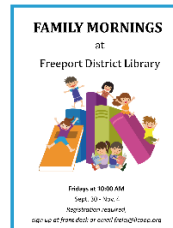
Saturday Hours 9-11am
